sub-specialty fellowship in Neuroradiology at the University of Miami's Jackson Memorial Medical Center.

Dr. Akerman has served as a Forensic Radiology Expert Witness for both Plaintiff and Defense on a variety of Medical Malpractice, Personal Injury and Product Liability cases. He places great importance on being a patient advocate, due to his unique personal background as having once been a patient himself.
